

Exciting news! Our neighborhood is partnering with Our Towns **Habitat for Humanity** to pick up your donations of new and gently used items. The pick up will begin around **1PM** just after the **Skybrook Spring Yard Sale** on **Saturday, April 20<sup>th</sup>**. So sign up for the yard sale and have no worries about taking items back inside that aren't sold. Habitat volunteers will have clearly marked trucks in the neighborhood so we'll drive to your home, load donations, and arrange to get you a receipt for tax deduction. This weekend, a flyer will be put into your mailbox tube that can be placed with the items at your driveway that are intended for Habitat donation. It is that easy!

If you are not participating in the yard sale, you can still arrange for Habitat to pick up items you wish to donate. Habitat can come inside to load larger items too but advance scheduling is preferred.
